**NEW MANAGEMENT CONTRACT FOR MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SCOTTISH TRUNK ROAD NETWORK – NORTH WEST UNIT
A85 TRUNK ROAD MAINTENANCE – COMRIE EAST – INFORMATION LETTER**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION WITH REGARDS TO SPECIAL WASTE INCLUDED BELOW

BEAR Scotland, on behalf of Transport Scotland, are planning to carry out carriageway resurfacing works on the A85 through the village of Comrie, between Bridge Street (Community Centre) and Comrie Skate Park. A location plan has been enclosed for your information.

Works are planned to take place between Sunday 4th and Wednesday 21st December 2022. Please see table below for programme of works:

Carriageway Resurfacing Works

Carriageway resurfacing works are planned for construction between Sunday 4th to Thursday 15th December 2022, with no work taking place on Friday or Saturday nights. Works will be carried out between the hours of 6pm and 2am each night. Please note, this is the maximum available working window and as such, works may finish earlier, depending on progress achieved each night. In an effort to minimise disruption to nearby residents, the loudest work activities will cease by 11pm each night.

Operations will be carried out under a lane closure where a 10mph convoy traffic management system will be in place. Out with working hours the traffic management will be removed, however, driver awareness is encouraged as road users will be travelling over a temporary surface. Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.

Whilst works progress adjacent to B827 Bridge Street Junction, access to the A85 Trunk Road from Bridge Street, and vice versa, will be prohibited to allow works to progress safely. A signed diversion route will be in place via B827, A822 and Crieff, as per the enclosed diversion plan.

Due to the presence of on street parking limiting access to the full carriageway, parking restrictions will be in place from Comrie Skate Park to Bridge of Lednock between 5pm and 5am each night, from
