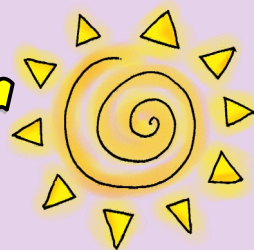

- * Only one car should be parked at each caravan - additional cars should be parked in one of chipped parking areas or outside the office
