Wifi next steps



You may be aware of the work that has been undertaken already to improve our wifi on the park, including installation of a new generation receiver for StarLink and additional points on the park. Sadly, nothing has been satisfactory for us but we continue to work with Cabin Comms. We apologise for this ongoing issue.

We are now looking towards a 5G solution to work alongside our StarLink and engineers will be present on the park again to conduct testing.

The wifi is provided free of charge as part of our park infrastructure. For those needing a more reliable feed just now, I would suggest purchasing your own mobile wifi for now. Vodafone is the best in terms of signal and speed.

New Office



Our new office will soon have skirting and decking, with a ramp and stairs for access. We opted for PVC decking and skirting, with steel construction to allow for heavy duty use. This should be complete within the next few weeks.

The new decking will run the length of the office and will be 8 feet wide. It will be anthracite and grey to match the new building, with smoky grey glass to finish it off.

There will be space for tables and chairs, rattan sofas etc and we encourage you to come and use the space to catch up with other park users or to watch the world going past.

Going forward, we will be able to host get togethers in our new building to help people meet the new members of our community.







Work is well underway on the Comrie Flood Defences, with the landscape of Comrie changing before our eyes. Whilst we tolerate the necessary disruption, we remember the huge difference this will make to villagers badly affected by flooding in the past, as well as the finished product to enjoy on our doorstep.

Work on the field is focusing on the construction of the bund, with foundations laid to support this structure. Work in front of Willow has created an access road and bridge across the Lednock to facilitate machinery and materials access to the boulevard.
